Introducing: Repel Gel



Repel Gel is a non-toxic water soluble polymer clay medium. Repel Gel prevents polymer clay from adhering to itself while curing. It can also be used as a mold and stamp release. Create braids, loops, purses, fringe, curled hair effects, photo frames, and luggage tags. Water clean-up. 3/4 fl oz (22ml) jar. Packed 6 per box.

General directions: Use a paint brush to apply a thin coat of Repel Gel to the surface of the clay where adhesion is not desired. Align second layer of clay and gently press area where adhesion is desired. You can do this while Repel Gel is still wet or after it has dried (dries in approximately 10 minutes). Cure piece at recommended time and temperature. Cool. Separate clay where Repel Gel is applied. Rinse any residue off with cold water.

Making a Pouch with Repel Gel and Kato Polyclay™



Step 1. Brush Repel Gel on polymer clay areas where you want to create a resist to prevent adhesion in the curing phase.



Step 2. Apply second layer of clay. It is not necessary to let the Repel Gel dry.



Step 3. Apply pressure to parts of the clay where fusing is desired and bake the clay normally. Cool.



You're finished. You have made a pouch from polymer clay.



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
